## 'ESCape' Extended School Club!

We are delighted to confirm the extension of our school day with wrap around care starting from 7:30a.m. in Breakfast Club, through to 5.30p.m daily, with Fliss King and Hayley Morgan in ESCape! Club. ESCape! will start at 4:15p.m. following after-school clubs for parents requiring additional childcare, and children will be able to relax and enjoy our newly refurbished community room 'The Hub' with a snack and refreshments.

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## Whole School Refurbishment \& I.T. Upgrade

I am also delighted to inform you of the refurbishment project which will be taking place during the summer holidays. All corridors and classrooms will be redecorated in a fresh and vibrant colour scheme to represent the energy and enthusiasm of the school and the children. We have also invested considerably in the school's I.T. infrastructure, with a $£ \mathbf{3 0 , 0 0 0}$ upgrade to our internet cabling earlier this year, and a further $£ \mathbf{3 0}, \mathbf{0 0 0}$ upgrade to install Promethean Touchscreens in every classroom and intervention room.

We very much hope that we will be able to invite parents and carers into school again next year for Workshops, Book Sales, Cake Bakes, Book Fairs, Share mornings and other exciting events!

As part of these planned improvements we will also be developing our Yoga Room into 'The Studio', fit for yoga, music, drama, dance and other activities, and our community room into 'The Hub', providing children with a comfortable and nurturing environment in which to relax, bake, craft and create!

The classroom structure for 2021/2022 will also enable us to offer Intervention Rooms for each Key Stage, enabling small group work in an engaging learning environment.

## Learning Support

We have a fabulous team of Learning Support Assistants who play a vital and important role in the teaching and learning of our pupils. I am delighted to advise you that we are investing further in our LSA Team - and the outcomes of every pupil - with the appointment of two new and highly skilled Learning Support Assistants, providing every Class with a dedicated full-time LSA from Year 1 to Year 6.
