## **Covid prevention measures from Monday 22<sup>nd</sup> November**

As you may have read or heard, the Director of Public Health for Suffolk and the Director for Children and Young People's Services have directed all Suffolk schools to continue with additional Covid measures.

This means that:

- **All adult visitors to the school, both inside and outside must wear a face covering, unless medically exempt;**
- **All staff in communal areas, both inside and outside must wear a face covering, unless medically exempt;**
- **Children will NOT have to wear face coverings whilst at our school;**
- **Only essential visitors will be allowed into our school building (this means parents and carers may be invited to online meetings instead);**
- **We will not be holding any further assemblies or meetings indoors, unless absolutely necessary;**
- **We will continue with our one-way system outdoors;**
- **Daily LFD testing of staff who are close contacts of positive cases, should also take a **PCR test on day 5** from first contact with the symptomatic positive case;**
- **Suffolk also recommends children who are close contacts with a positive case, do this as well.**

Thank you again for your continued support; we appreciate how diligent everyone is being in keeping children off who are poorly, arranging for Covid tests, and isolating as families with positive cases. This has helped us to keep the numbers of cases low and to keep the school open as normal.
