Senior Leadership Team update

Mr. Culpin and myself have been planning with our Governors the leadership team for Phoenix going forwards.

From parental surveys and also comments from several of you in the playground you are really keen for the school to have stability and consistency. This is a concern that we have taken on board.

Therefore, I am delighted to tell you that Mrs. Freeman applied for, was interviewed and has been appointed to be the permanent Deputy Headteacher of Phoenix St. Peter Academy! This will give the school a lot of leadership experience, children and parents consistency with SEND and also Designated Safeguarding Leader (DSL).

I am also delighted to share with you that I will remain with Phoenix St. Peter next academic year and Mr. Culpin will transfer the role of Executive Headteacher to me. This will mean I will spend at least half of my working week at Phoenix St. Peter Academy next year, continuing to build on the progress and improvements we are making, with the rest of my working week being at Gunton Primary in North Lowestoft. Our progress has included you as parents being so supportive of the school. For example, our attendance remains significantly above national averages at present – thank you!

Reminders
